

## **EXTRA DAY SCORES**

Besides participating in qualifying competitions, players may for handicap purposes, return <u>EXTRA DAY SCORES</u> (EDS) by observing the following procedure:

- Before starting the round, the player must register with office including name of marker, name(s) of playing partner(s) and exact handicaps
- ♦ When you complete your round, your scorecard must be returned to the office, duly completed and signed by player and marker. A non-returned card may result in a penalty score being applied to your handicap record.
- ♦ Either full the 18-hole round or the front 9-hole round may be played for EDS, but you must decide before your round whether you will be playing 9 or 18 holes, and inform the office accordingly.
- ♦ Handicap Conditions apply (use of correct tees, summer greens only).

  Round must be played under R&A Rules applicable to a qualifying competition.

  In the early or late season, when the normal tees are not in use and course plays shorter EDS are not accepted.
- ♦ There are no limits for the handicaps of either the player or marker for extra day scores to count, but both player and marker must have a valid current WHS handicap index.
- ♦ Players may mutually mark their scores
- **♦** CBA procedure is not applicable
